The safety training is very important together with the communications training that helps the crew on the ground be able to always communicate with the operator.

Because of the extreme environments these machinery work under, they are usually put under incredible strain regularly. This means there are a lot of heavy equipment jobs available for the maintenance and repair of the machines. Heavy machinery operators are highly skilled workers who could troubleshoot, repair and diagnose heavy machines in a work shop or on site. On occasion it might be possible for delivery drivers to operate machinery with just a simple CDL. Then again, several jobs will need more specific training.
