The load is projected out from the front of the machinery so it is visible to the driver of the forklift. This kind of forklift truck should just be utilized on prepared surface or on level, stable ground.

Forklift drivers are required to receive training which will allow them to better know the proper or right way across the arms of the forklift. The trainee would learn to correctly lower and raise the load vertically and how to tilt the mast of the lift truck, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both backwards and forwards. Trainees would be taught the RTITB standards needed for safely operating the forklift. Trainees would likewise know the kinds of attachments for the arms of the forklift.

Types of Counterbalance Forklifts:

Walkie Pallet Trucks

Walkie Pallet Truck is a counterbalance forklift suitable for getting into spaces that are small and cramped. This particular lift is very maneuverable and can access almost any tight space.

Walkie Stackers
